Larson introduced the presenters for today's discussion. Goals, plans for testing and expected outcomes for Loon Lake within the first year were discussed. The group plans to test and monitor the water quality before treating, during and after the treatment. The request today was to direct staff to work with this group on a plan and find a pricing structure to move forward to help improve the water quality.
